THE LAW SCHOOL OF TANZANIA (CURRICULUM) (REVOCATION) BY-LAWS, 2024

Citation

1. These By-Laws may be cited as the Law School of Tanzania (Curriculum) (Revocation) By-Laws, 2024.

Revocation, savings and transition GN. No. 171 of 2011

- 2.-(1) The Law School of Tanzania (Curriculum) By-Laws, 2011 are hereby revoked.
- (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subparagraph (1), the revocation of the Law School of Tanzania (Curriculum) By-Laws, 2011 shall not affect or invalidate anything lawfully done under or pursuant to the revoked By-Laws.
- (3) Notwithstanding the revocation of the Law School of Tanzania (Curriculum) By-Laws, 2011, where, at the commencement of these By-Laws, a student is required to supplement and clear any failed course component, such student shall clear such course component within a period of five years from the date of commencement of these By-Laws, and in accordance with the provisions of the revoked By-Laws.

(4) Where the period of five years prescribed under subparagraph (3) expires, the supplement and clearance of failed courses under the revoked By-Laws shall cease and the student shall be required to repeat the training program in accordance with existing training curriculum.
