Examinations 22A.-(1) Where a candidate of any program fails to sit for all or part of examination due to sufficient reason and upon proof of the same to the Principal of School, the candidate |

will be allowed to sit for special examination.

(2) The special examination under this paragraph may be conducted during regular examination period or at any time as may be determined by the Principal of School.

(3) A candidate who sits for special examination and upon publication of the results, is required to sit for supplementary examination, shall comply with requirements of paragraph 22.”.
